Purpose

Governing Rules and Eligibility

 - d. Be otherwise qualified and eligible to receive an award under applicable regulations.



Bid Procedure and closing date

- 7. Proposals are due on 25 May 2022 at 15h00 (Brussels time).

Evaluation Criteria and Contract Award.

- 8. Bidders will be evaluated on the documentation submitted, and other information and documentation available to the Organization. Considerations include: understanding of requirements and proposed approach and solution; bidder's resources and capabilities; past performance; legal risks and the proposed price.
- 9. The contract will be awarded to the responsible Bidder whose conforming proposal represents the best value after evaluation in accordance with the factors and sub-factors specified in the solicitation. The detailed proposal evaluation factors, their relative importance, and the phases of the source selection process are described in Part I, Section 8, of the RFP.
