Purpose

- 1. In accordance with the provisions of Article XXXII of the NATO Financial Regulations and Financial Rules and Procedures, we are pleased to inform you that the RFP stated above has been issued by the NATO IS Procurement Service.
- 2. The purpose of this RFP is to award a single contract for the acquisition of an Open Source Intelligence (OSINT) Artificial Intelligence (Al) Alerting Platform to be provided by the selected Contractor that meet the needs of the NATO Situational Centre (SITCEN).
- 3. An electronic version of the RFP has been posted on the NATO IS Business Opportunities web-site www.nato.int/structur/procurement.

Governing Rules and Eligibility

- 4. This procurement action will follow the International Competitive Bidding procedure specified in Reference A.
- 5. To be eligible to participate in the bidding process, Bidders must:
 - a. Be from one of the NATO Member Nations;
 - b. Having performed at least three contracts within the last three years substantially similar in scope to the requirements described in this solicitation;
 - c. Having a sound financial and legal standing and sufficient capacity and resources to provide the services specified in the Statement of Work;
 - d. Be otherwise qualified and eligible to receive an award under applicable regulations.
