Subject: NOTIFICATION OF INTENT (NOI) TO ISSUE AN INVITATION FOR INTERNATIONAL BIDDING/PROPOSAL (IFIB/IFIP) FOR PROVISION OF ELECTRONIC WARFARE SERVICES FOR NATO TRAINING AND EXERCISES

1. In accordance with the stipulations of the Bi-SC procurement Directive 60-70, Annex C, the following information is provided on an Invitation for International Bidding/Proposal (IFIB/IFIP) that this Headquarters has the intention to release.

IFIB/IFIP reference number : ACO-RAM-22-11..

Title of IFIB/IFIP : Provision of Electronic Warfare Services for NATO Training and Exercises

Type of contract : Firm Fixed Price Contract, requirement contract

Period of performance : One Base Period: 01 January 2023 – 31 December 2023 with a further four (4) one-year extension options subject to funds availability and contract authority approval from the Budget Committee as per para 2-12 (b) of above mentioned directive.

Transition Period : 1st DEC 2022 – 31. DEC. 2022

Bidding procedure : Lowest price technically compliant; the ACO eBid portal will be used for the competition URL: <https://aco.procureware.com>

Eligible firms who are interested to participate in this competition are invited to apply for registration on the ACO eBid portal unless they already hold status of approved/registered vendor

Funding : Yearly estimated cost 1,600,000.00 €. The estimated total contract value is 8.000.000,00 €.

Classification : NATO UNCLASSIFIED

Issue Date : 21 June 2022.

Closing Date : **08 September 2022, 1600 hours (Central European Summer time)**

Eligibility : Eligible sources are restricted to *Governmental or Commercial entities (1) that originate and are chartered/incorporated within NATO-member nations, (2) that maintain a professionally active facility (office, factory, laboratory, etc.) within NATO-member nations and (3) that provide the funding for the aforementioned requirement.* This invitation to bid is not open to (1) Joint Venture and or any type of temporary grouping of companies (2) Consortium of firms/companies.

NATO UNCLASSIFIED

All eligible companies must demonstrate that they have successfully performed at least 3 contracts with a minimum of five (5) year period of performance within the last five (5) years substantially similar in scope and magnitude to the requirements described in this solicitation.

Note: Bidders must have a NATO Security Clearance (classification NATO SECRET) company level security clearance and the bidder's personnel assigned for contract performance must have a NATO SECRET personal security clearance.

Partial bidding : partial bidding is not authorized
