

Notification of Intent - Restore Runway at Oerland Air Station, Norway – National Competitive Bidding Plus

Background

The Norwegian Defence Estates Agency (NDEA) - on behalf of the Ministry of Defence Norway - intends to issue an invitation to submit tender for three separate contracts under the rules and procedures for National Competitive Bidding Plus (NCB+), as defined by the NATO Security Investment Programme (NSIP). The project will cover restoration of the runway, shoulders and adjacent security areas at Oerland Air Station, located in the North-West region of Norway, near the city of Trondheim. With this Notification of Intent, (NOI), the NDEA aims to ensure that eligible firms from any NATO member nation are informed of and invited to participate in the upcoming competition.

In accordance with the NATO rules and regulations, firms from the following NATO member nations may participate in the competition:

Albania, Belgium, Bulgaria, Canada, Croatia, Czechia, Denmark, Estonia, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Montenegro, Netherlands, North Macedonia, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Türkiye, United Kingdom, United States.

Contract arrangement

The procurement will be split into three separate main contracts as follows:

Contract no C03168 Mass Removal and Re-establishment of the runway

This contract will cover all mass removal and reestablishment of the runway, shoulders and safety area of the runway.

The contract holds an estimated value of Euro 25 000 000

Contract will be announced January 31 2023

Execution of the contract is planned for the third quarter of 2023 through fourth quarter of 2024.

Contract no C03172 Electrical works

This contract will cover restoration of runway lighting.

The contract holds an estimated value of Euro 1 000 000

Contract will be announced January 17 2023

Execution of the contract is planned for the third quarter of 2023 through fourth quarter of 2024.

Contract no C03173 Asphalt Works

This contract will cover resurfacing of the runway and shoulders with asphalt.

The contract holds an estimated value of Euro 10 000 000

Contract will be announced January 10 2023

Execution of the contract is planned for April 2024 through September 2024, and contingent upon seasonal conditions

Time Scheduling

The IFB documents are expected to be issued January 2023, see details per contract in sections above. Bid Closing Date will be announced in the separate IFB documents.

Firms that wish to participate and receive the Invitation for Bid documents, must declare their interest by contacting primary Point of Contact (POC) listed below no later than February 1, 2023, at 12:00 Central European Time. Interested parties will receive the Invitation for Bid documentation directly from the primary POC.

The Invitation for Bid documentation will be written in the Norwegian language.

Security

The Invitation for Bid documentation will be unclassified.

The successful bidder will have to provide personnel that can be authorised to handle information up to and including NATO RESTRICTED. For key personnel on site, a valid NATO Security Clearance up to and including NATO CONFIDENTIAL is required. This applies to all three contracts.
